**5 Edible & S** Fisheries Management Notice No. 32 of 2010 has the effect of RE-OPENING the Biologically Sensitive Area (BSA) for fishing for, transhipment or having on board Edible Crab or Spider Crab by Irish sea-fishing boats over 10metres with effect from the 19th October, 2010.
