4 **Skates & Rays** - Landings of the Common Skate, White Skate and Undulate Ray are prohibited however, there are special requirements in relation to Cookoo Ray, Thorny Back Ray, Blondie Ray, Spotted Ray, Sandy Ray and Shagreen Ray.

5 **Edible & Spider Crab** - From 00.01 hrs on 1st Oct 2010 an Irish sea fishing boat over 10 metres, Master thereof or person on board shall not fish for or have on board Edible & Spider Crab in the Biologically Sensitive Area - BSA. BSA means waters falling within the area enclosed by the coast of Ireland to the south of 53 30'N and to the West of 07 00'W and straight lines sequentially joining the following geographical co-ordinates:
a point on the coast of Ireland at latitude 53 30'N
latitude 53 30' N, longitude 12 00' W
Latitude 53 00'N, longitude 12 00'W
latitude 51 00'N, longitude 11 00'W
latitude 49 30'N, longitude 11 00'W
latitude 49 30'N, longitude 07 00'W
a point on the coast of Ireland at longitude 07 00'W
