in relation to the reporting of landings of Cookoo Ray, Thorny Back Ray, Blondie Ray, Spotted Ray, Sandy

Ray and Shagreen Ray.

4 BOARFISH Vessels with an individual vessel allocation should check their Authorisation. All other vessels have a 5% by-catch

5 HERRING Area VII b, c & ViaS (North West Herring) - FVs under 20m is = 0 Ton

6 MACKEREL Area VI,VII, VIIIa,b,d,e: FV's Less than 18m (except FVs fishing by hook & lines) without individual allocation = 3 Ton

<15m FVs fishing by means of hook & lines may retain on board or land up to 750kg of Mackerel on occasion

but may not carry nets of < 80mm when availing of derogation.

7. SOLE f-g Please note that this will become a Choke Species if landings of even these small quantities continue.
